Title: Collection Yvon Morneau (YM)

Dates: 1953-1961.

Extent of descriptive unit: Nine digital photos on a DVD.

Administrative history or biography: Born in 1948, Yvon Morneau lived in Kabina, a small community located about 32 kilometers west of Hearst, from 1952 to 1961. His father, Roger Morneau, worked at J.D. Levesque sawmill. As a child, he attended school in Kabina and witnessed the evolution of the logging village. When the sawmill closed, the family left the village and settled in Hearst.

In 2017, Yvon Morneau donated his collection of digital photos to Le Centre d'archives de la Grande Zone argileuse.

Scope and content: The collection contains nine photos, showing the logging village's installations and members of the Morneau family, from 1953 to 1961.

Sources of information: The information was obtained from the donor.

Physical description: The collection includes nine digital photos on a DVD. The originals were given back to the donor.

Immediate source of acquisition: Le Centre d'archives de la Grande Zone argileuse acquired the collection from Yvon Morneau, in 2017.

Arrangement: The original order of the photos was respected and the donor's notes were transcribed.

Language: The photos' descriptions are in French.

Restriction on access: No restriction imposed by the donor.

Terms governing use and reproduction: Copyright Act applies. Reproduction permitted depending on the condition of the documents.

Finding aids: None.
