Title: Collection HighGrader Magazine (HG)

Dates: 1995-2017.

Extent of descriptive unit: 0.41 m of textual documents.

Administrative history or biography: Launched in Cobalt, by musician and politician Charlie Angus and his wife Britt Griffin, the first issue of the HighGrader Magazine was published in January 1995. The English-language magazine intended to raise awareness to Northern Ontario's realities. While focusing on all aspects of Northern Ontario's rural lifestyle, the magazine indicated in its first issue that it intended to pay special attention to cultural activities and to promote the artists and writers of the region. In 2004, Syl Belisle a former publisher of Timmins bought the magazine and published it until 2017. Mr. Belisle passed away in 2017.

Scope and content: This collection includes a complete series of HighGrader Magazine published between January 1995 to Winter 2017.

Sources of information: HighGrader Magazine.

Physical description: The collection contains three boxes of textual documents.

Immediate source of acquisition: Part of the collection was acquired in 2014 thanks to a donation from Lauré Girard. The collection was completed as a result of a donation from Ann Siska, in 2019.

Language: English.

Restriction on access: No restriction imposed by the donor.

Terms governing use and reproduction: Copyright Act applies. Reproduction permitted depending on the condition of the documents.
