**Title:** Collection Les Nouvelles de Timmins (NT)

Dates: 2003, 2005–2011.

**Extent of descriptive unit:** 0.79 m of textual documents.

**Administrative history or biography:** The French-language weekly *Les Nouvelles de Timmins* was founded in Timmins, in 1996. For a time, the newspaper was called *Les Nouvelles de Timmins et les environs* and was later known as *Les Nouvelles*. In 2002, it was combined with the Daily Press, of Timmins. The weekly disappeared in 2011.

**Scope and content:** The collection includes an incomplete series of the newspaper in a printed form.

**Sources of information:** Timmins Public Library, 2018.

**Physical description:** The collection includes most of the publications from 2005 to 2011. There is also a copy of a 2003 issue.

**Immediate source of acquisition:** The collection, a donation from la Bibliothèque Maurice-Saulnier, was acquired in 2013.

**Arrangement:** The documents, once acquired, were organized by the archivist.

Language: French.

**Restriction on access:** No restriction imposed by the donor.

**Terms governing use and reproduction:** Copyright Act applies. Reproduction permitted depending on the condition of the documents.

**Finding aids:** A detailed inventory exists.

**Associated materials:** Collection journaux et revues de la Grande Zone argileuse, Collection Daily Press.
